\*\*Taken only by Licensed Practical Nurses who have been admitted to the program and have met the prerequisites. Acceptance into the program is based on a selective admissions process. In order to be considered for admission, applicants must comply with college and program admission requirements. Licensed practical nurses who graduated within one year of admission to the program or have practiced at least one full year within the past three years and hold a current unrestricted license for practical nursing will be admitted to the associate degree level. Proof of active status on the Kentucky Medicaid Nurse Aide Registry or its equivalent is required prior to enrolling in the first nursing course. Progression in the nursing program is contingent upon achievement of a grade of "C" or better in each biological science, nursing and mathematics course and maintenance of a 2.0 cumulative grade point average or better (on a 4.0 scale).
